<p>Quality: UWS is a council-accredited landlord. Our rooms and flats are in good repair and well furnished. We also have kitchen items and cleaners in communal areas.</p>	<p>Quality: You may take on a flat with grubby or unsafe furniture. It can be costly to buy items to make your flat feel homely and clean. Before you move in you will likely need to do lots of cleaning and preparation to get it ready for living in.</p>
<p>Community: Being part of UWS Accommodation you get to be part of something bigger. With year-round Res-Life events; peer to peer support from friendly Res-Life ambassadors & the chance to meet other UWS students. As well as access to exclusive discounts and offers.</p>	<p>Community: You may not always have good neighbors. There may not be a ready-made community on the doorstep to get involved with.
